

100 Percent of Users Surveyed Say the IVEA Makes it Easier to Ambulate Patients with Fewer Staff

IVEA Clinical Trials: Results Analysis

During the latter part of 2015, Firefly Medical conducted clinical trials of the IVEA at five hospitals around the country. During each trial nurses and other caregivers used the equipment over a two to five day period and then completed a written evaluation of their experience using a standardized form.

A few of the patients who were placed on the IVEA also asked to express their enthusiasm for the product by completing an evaluation form. More than 80 forms were submitted, and the results were overwhelmingly positive.

Results Analysis

In one section of the Trial Evaluation Form participants were asked to rate their experience of several benefits of the IVEA as Excellent, Good, Fair or N/A. In another they were asked to respond to a series of Yes or No questions.

For the purpose of analysis, each of the rating criteria was assigned a score:

- ⇒ EXCELLENT SCORE 3
- ⇒ GOOD SCORE 2
- ⇒ FAIR SCORE 1

The data were analyzed in two ways:

- ⇒ **Averaging the scores for the benefits.** The maximum score equals 3. The average score over all the benefits equals 2.85 with very little variation amongst the benefits.
- ⇒ Frequency analysis of the 3 criteria: EXCELLENT, GOOD and FAIR. Blank answers indicating that the respondent did not have an opportunity to experience the particular benefit were not taken up in the analysis. The results are expressed as the percentage of respondents in each criterion.
- ⇒ Frequency analysis of the YES/NO questions.

The extraordinary results are presented here in numeric and graphic form.




FEED BACK FROM HOSPITAL STAFF AND PATIENTS DURING TRIALS.



SCORE ANALYSIS




FREQUENCY ANALYSIS
